



DEAR EVAN HANSEN EXTENDS ITS MANILA RUN UNTIL OCTOBER 5

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Manila – Due to the overwhelming response from the Filipino audience, GMG Productions announced today the final extension of the critically acclaimed, Tony Award-winning musical *Dear Evan Hansen* in Manila. The production will now run from **September 4 to October 5, 2025**, at **The Theatre at Solaire**.
